Improving the major transnational transport connections between the parties with a view to stimulating sustainable economic growth at the local/regional and global levels;





- Accelerating the implementation of transport and logistics infrastructure projects along the major transnational connections, and facilitate the approval of projects of mutual interest;

II. The MOU on the Northern Dimension Partnership on Transport and Logistics is aiming at

- Accelerating the removal of non-infrastructure related bottlenecks, affecting the flow of transport in and across the region, and facilitate the improvement of logistics in international supply chains;
- Directorate General for Mobility and Transport

- Setting up effective structures to monitor the implementation of the proposed projects and measures.
