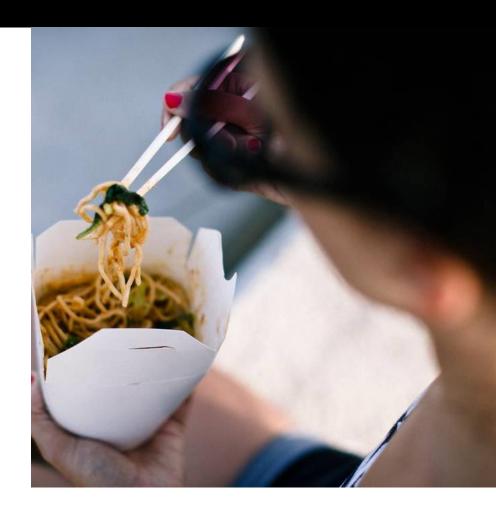

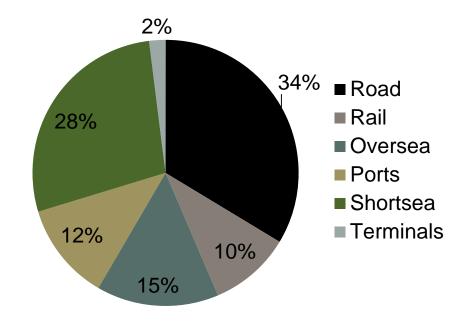

Transport cost of MEUR 1.000 /year



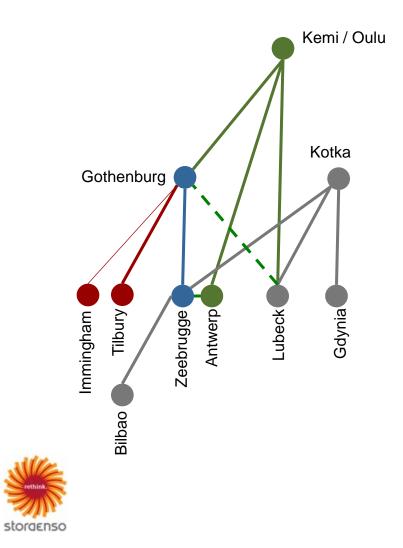

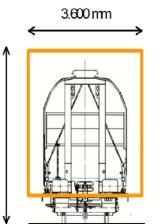








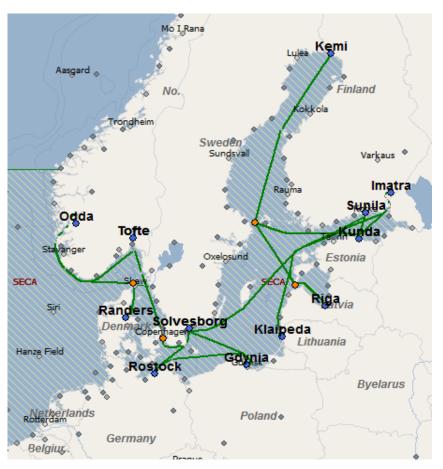




# Load Profile C - Sweden

#### Vessel bunker consumption ton per 24h at various speed



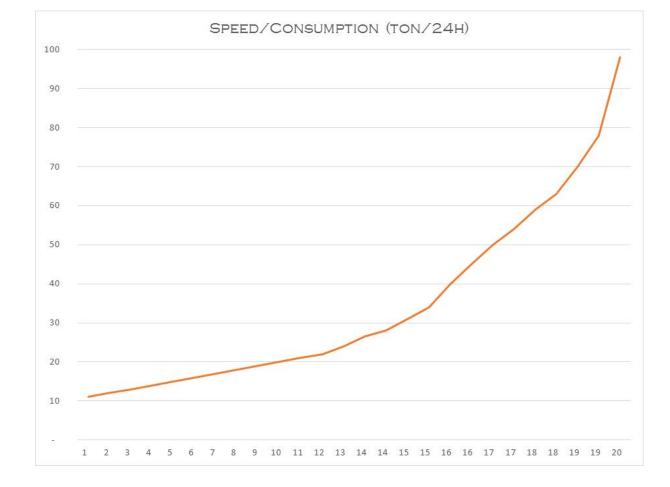

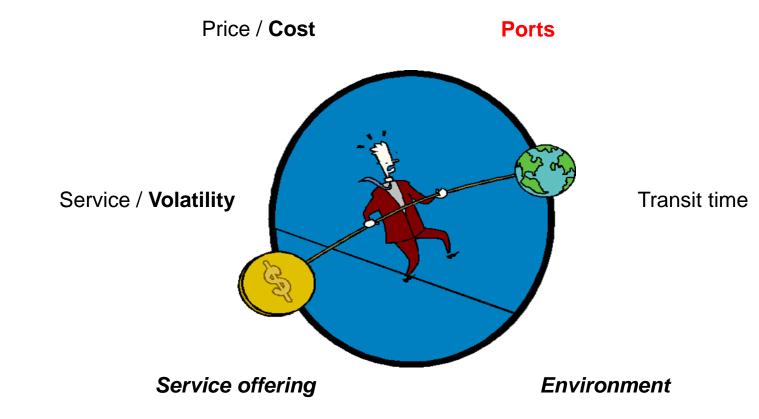
